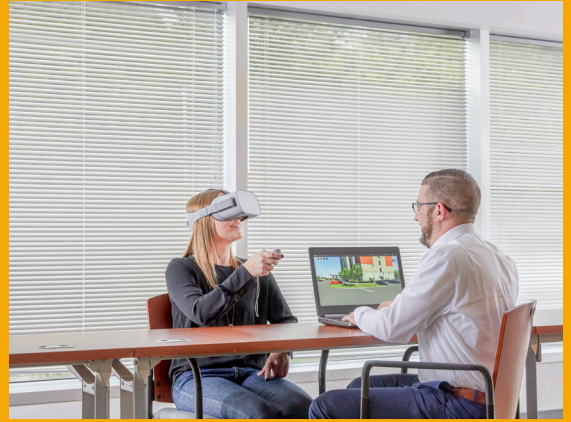

Pittsburgh International Airport Master Plan | Pittsburgh, PA

CEC is engaged in creating a vision and land development strategy for more than 5,000 acres of non-aeronautical land surrounding the airport. The approach involves defining a range of economic clusters, targeted industries, commercial/economic development functions, and end users/investors so that this master plan becomes a vital marketing and implementation tool.

Industrial Scientific Global Headquarters | Pittsburgh, PA

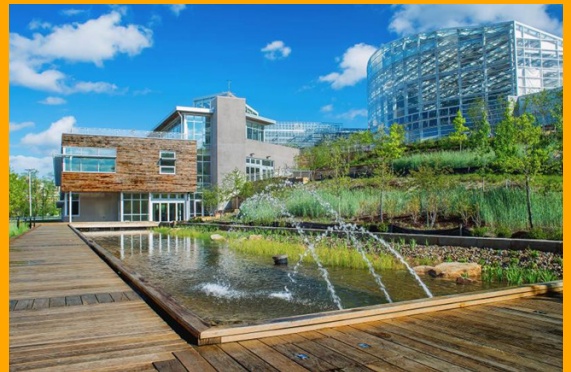
CEC provided civil engineering, surveying, geotechnical, and ecological services for the construction of the 330,000-square-foot Industrial Scientific Corporation Global Headquarters building, including an eight-story office tower, a two-story warehouse and manufacturing wing, lab space, and an eight-story open atrium, along with underground parking and an additional parking garage.

Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens Center for Sustainable Landscapes | Pittsburgh, PA

CEC led final strategy development addressing the imperatives of net-zero water and sustainable water discharge for Phipps' new center for education, research, and administrative operations. CEC performed topographic and utility surveys; Phase I Environmental Site Assessments; geotechnical engineering; and civil engineering, including grading, stormwater collection and management, sanitary treatment and reuse system design, water distribution design, and green infrastructure performance monitoring system design and installation. The project resulted in 87% annual reduction in roof runoff and 100% capture of rain garden stormwater. It is the first and only project to attain the planet's four highest sustainable building certifications, and has received a number of awards.

Air Quality Support for Williams | PA, WV, and OH

To provide the best possible service to Williams, CEC is engaged at all levels, including construction, engineering, project management, planning, scheduling, operations, corporate environmental, and field environmental. CEC submitted and obtained air permits for multiple compressor stations and met the demanding schedule so that Williams was able to succeed within its construction and operation schedule constraints.
